Everything begins at **10am** with a spectacular opening ceremony!

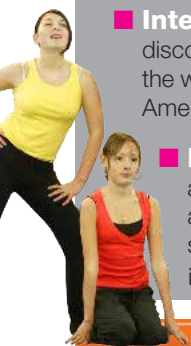
■ **International Food Zone:**

■ By Cycle

From the M32, junction 1, follow the A4174 signs to Filton, go through 2 sets of traffic lights, at the first roundabout (MOD and retail), follow signs to Parkway. At the next roundabout, turn left. Parking is at Aviva, (follow signs).
